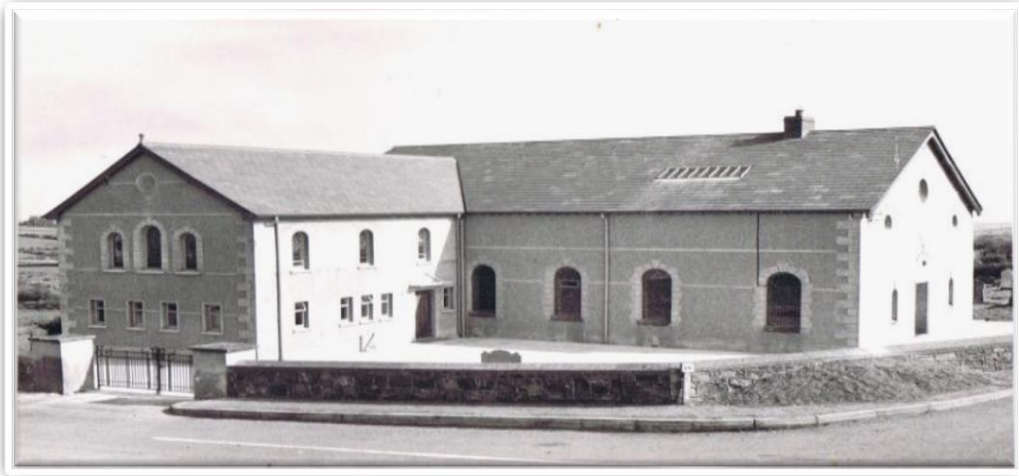

Worship the LORD in the splendor of his holiness. ³⁰ Tremble before him all the earth!
